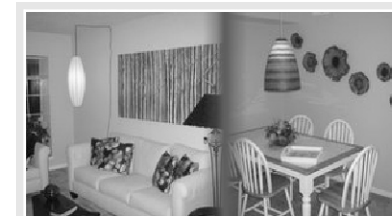
outstanding programs offering hope and humor, information and support to patients, survivors and their caregivers.
